About <u>76%</u> of Arizona teens graduate on time, but Boys & Girls Clubs are making a real difference – 97% of Club teens expect to graduate on time, and 86% expect to attend college. Aided by caring teen specialists and youth development professionals, Club members spend their high school years participating in character and leadership development programs, exploring academic and career pathways, and building positive relationships with friends and mentors who prepare them for post–graduate success and beyond.
